We place disinfectant alcohol at the reception counter to sanitise your hands.

The liquid soap is available to wash your hands in our toilet.

Please kindly refrain from visiting us if you have any symptom of fever or lethargy.

We do not take your temperature at the entrance. We will rely on your discretion.

We will refrain from holding our special tea ceremony sessions, handling sessions and gallery talks for a time being.
